

## What is a men's ministry?

- It's two (2) associates meeting for lunch and prayer
- It's a golf tournament used for the purposes of reaching others for Christ
- It's a Resurrection dinner / breakfast for the purpose of inviting unsaved friends, relatives, neighbors, business associates to hear the Gospel message and have an opportunity to make a decision for Christ
- It's fathers and sons getting together for a weekend of fun and fellowship
- It's about men inviting their male work and neighborhood friends to the next PK conference
- It's men working closely and partnering with our missionaries and even participating in short term mission trips.

It's about men relating to and sharing with other men; investing in other men; discipling other men; evangelizing with other men; serving with other men; praying with other men; befriending other men; supporting other men; ministering to other men and the community.

Today's American male can be described as individuals who compete, compare, are isolated, and self-sufficient.
